Linc Services' scope of work, for the school's main building, included the conversion of chilled water pumping systems from constant to variable speed; two new 200 ton high-efficiency chillers; 250,000 square feet of new high-efficiency lighting; variable speed drive upgrades to air handling units; air balancing of classrooms; and revisions of control sequences for improved sequence of operations. Construction on the project was completed in April 2007.
